## Summary of Project

The project included the skilled restoration and consolidation of the derelict walls and buildings as part of a long term aim to gain recognition as a National Heritage Site. Work was also carried out on the supporting walls of a large 32ft diameter waterwheel pit. The mines illustrate well the copper processing industry of the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> century and show the use of water power in the processing of the copper ore.
